

ACTION PLAN MEETING

In pursuance to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in WP © No. 4299/2006, meeting of the revised Action Plan took place today i.e. on **28.01.2015** in the chamber of the undersigned. The Deputy Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police are not available in the town. Sri R Ahmed, ACS the Sub Divisional Officer and Dr D Ghanawat IPS, the Additional SP has attended the meeting representing the Deputy Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police. All Judicial officers are in attendance.

DISCUSSION AND DECISIONS:


1. What has been noted is that the good practice of sending **monthly report** by each of the police station has been discontinued. Earlier the O/C of all the Police Stations in Udalguri DEF was sending a monthly report containing information about the number of summons, warrant etc. received and the percentage of execution of those processes. The Deputy SP (HQ) was responsible to ensure that the monthly reports are received. Hence the meeting resolved to ask the Deputy SP (HQ) to ensure that all O/Cs send their monthly report. It was further resolved that the Superintendent of Police would ask the Deputy SP (HQ) to submit a compliance report addressed to CJM Udalguri every month.
2. Another factor that was discussed was the circular issued by ADGP (Administration) vide Memo No G/VI/30/2000/Pt-A/90 dated 24.09.2014 directing that properly verified address of the accused should only be given in the charge sheet. The circular also demanded that investigating officer must furnish photograph and mobile number of the accused along with the charge

sheet. The meeting resolved to request the District Magistrate and the Superintendent of Police to ensure compliance of the circular for doing so would help ensure speedier disposal of cases.

3. The meeting took notice of the fact that the post of Prosecution Sub Inspector is lying vacant for long time now. The meeting resolved to request the SP (Udalguri) to take up the matter with Police Headquarter and ensure that an efficient policeman is posted to man the affairs of the PSI office.

4. The meeting also resolved to request the Superintendent of Police to instruct all the Police Station in the District to serve the summons at the earliest for prompt action.


With that the meeting ended.
