

MINUTES OF THE ACTION PLAN MEETING

Date: 23/06/2016

Place: Chamber of the District and Sessions Judge, Udalguri.

In pursuance to the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court in WP (C) Taken up No. 4299/2006, the meeting of the revised Action Plan took place today at 4.15 PM in the office chamber of the District Judge, Udalguri. The Deputy Commissioner – Udalguri, The Superintendent of Police – Udalguri, and the Judicial Officers of Udalguri District attended the meeting.

DISCUSSION AND THE RESOLUTIONS:

Agenda No. 1:- Disposal of old pending cases:-

The District and Sessions Judge informed that there are 29 old pending (5 years or more) cases pending in the district. He requested the Superintendent of Police to direct his subordinate to take up these cases on priority basis and help in the early disposal of these cases.

The Superintendent of Police has assured that he would help and asked for the list of those 29 cases. The list will be provided to him by tomorrow i.e. on 24.6.2016.

Agenda No.2:- Improvement in the charge-sheet:-

The various facets of charge-sheet were discussed and it was agreed that so far as possible the mobile numbers of the accused, the informant, the medical officer and the investigating officer would be provided in the charge-sheet. It was also agreed that in the next meeting the Joint Director Health Services and other senior medical officers would be invited to discuss matter relating to Post-mortem report, injury report and report in sexual assault cases. The Superintendent of Police informed that as so far S.R. cases are concerned he would take necessary steps for improving the quality of investigation.

Agenda No.3:- Monthly return of process:-

The District Judge brought to the notice of the District Superintendent of Police that the monthly return of the execution and non-execution of the summons and warrant has not been returned by the police stations under his jurisdiction. The Superintendent of Police asked for the format in which the return has to be submitted and assured that the monthly


return of the process as directed by the Hon'ble High Court would be submitted to the Chief Judicial Magistrate henceforth every month.

Any other matter :-

The CJM brought to the notice of the house an incident where some people approached a Judicial Magistrate in evening hours in a matter relating to grant of bail. The Superintendent of Police assured to look into the matter.

State Home:-


The CJM brought to the notice of the Deputy Commissioner that there is no State Home for keeping women/victim in cases where time is required to be given for reflection. The Deputy Commissioner assured to look into the matter and suggested that a Home is there at Tangla recognised by the Govt. and run by an NGO. The Deputy Commissioner assured to take follow up measures.
